Fathering, Family, Marriage and Children I
Fathering, Family, Marriage and Children II
A Covenant of Commitment with God
Counseling, Pastoral Care, and Love

Note: Each course contains several lessons, ensuring that you will receive in-depth knowledge on each topic. The courses of each program will be available for one year from the moment you enter the program. Completing the program entitles you to obtain a certificate from the University of the Supernatural Ministry (USM) that can be credited towards a ministerial degree program if you choose to go through the admission process, and are admitted as a regular college student. Entering the certificate program does not make you a regular USM student or guarantee admission in the future.
